Free entrance tickets are available for the following categories (as updated by Ministerial Decree 09 January 2019, n. 13):

- European Union citizens under 18 years of age;
- European Union tourist guides in the exercise of their professional activity by showing a proper ID;
- European Union tourist interpreters if their assistance is required alongside the tourist guide by showing proper ID;
- Personnel of Ministry for Cultural Heritage and Tourism;
- I.C.O.M. members (The International Council of Museums);
- Groups of students from the European Union public and private schools, accompanied by their teachers and authorized by the Museum Director;
- Italian School teachers with a permanent or fixed-term contract by showing a proper certification.
- Teachers and students of Art Academies, of the Faculties of Architecture, Conservation of the Cultural Heritage, Sciences of the Education, of the Arts and Humanities faculties with study paths in Archaeology, History or Art and of all the corresponding courses instituted in the Member States of the European Union, an ID is required;
- People with disabilities, an accompanying relative is also entitled to a free ticket;
- Members of voluntary associations that have entered an agreement with the Ministry and that promote and spread the knowledge of the Cultural Heritage.
